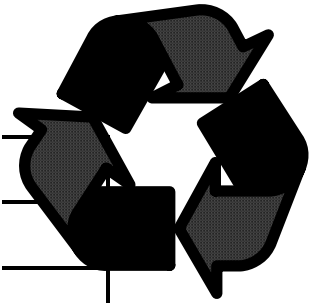

PRIOR TO BEING ABLE TO DISPOSE OF MATERIAL YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR LANDFILL PERMIT NUMBER TO THE ATTENDANT.

If you don't have a permit number, applications may be filled out at the Municipal Office Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or at the Landfill Sites.

RECYCLING

THE FOLLOWING MATERIAL WILL BE ACCEPTED:

- containers with a recycling triangle on the bottom containing the numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6 or 7 (new)
- steel (tin) food cans
- aluminum beverage cans
- polycoat (milk cartons, juice cartons, etc.)
- tetrapacks (juice boxes, etc.)
- newspapers and inserts, flyers, junk mail
- household paper, shredded paper and envelopes
- flattened cardboard - no more than one meter (39 inches) in any direction
- cardboard egg cartons and paper tubes
- flattened boxboard - cereal, cracker, shoe, tissue, laundry, packing boxes
- magazines, phone books, books (with the hard cover removed)

Crush plastic bottles, milk and juice cartons and aluminum cans to leave more room in your Blue Box
Remove plastic screw caps from containers
Rinse out your containers
REMEMBER, NO plastic bags please!

PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE:

- glass
- aerosol cans, propane bottles
- foil or foam takeout food containers
- plastic screw caps, toys, flower pots
- aluminum foil or foil pie plates, scrap metal, hangers
- anything containing a hazardous substance (motor oil, paint thinner, paint, etc.)
- plastic bags, plastic packaging and cellophane
- foam packaging, foam egg cartons or foam meat trays
